During the past 20 years her photography has won many awards including a National Addy Citation of Excellence and inclusion in numerous "Communication Arts" Annuals and "Graphis" Photography Annuals. She was recently featured in a cover story for the January/February 2004 Communication Arts magazine and is currently featured in the July 2004 edition of "View Camera" Magazine.

Rosanne's work has been included in many group and solo shows across the country. She is represented by the Robin Rice Gallery in New York, the Watermark Gallery in Houston and the Benham Gallery in her hometown of Seattle.
